Investing in our Growing Children's Ministry

Who would guess that on any given Sunday, Little Trinity House might accommodate upwards of 60 Sunday School children and 16 volunteers? Our Pre-School to Grade 6 program not only uses the classroom space that is intended for Sunday School use, but also spills over into the multi-purpose fireplace rooms at the front of the House. In the last several years, growth in the number of children who attend has necessitated the splitting up of classes that would normally meet together as well as the need for more teachers. Students in the Grade 5/6 class occasionally have to sit on the floor during their lesson because of lack of space. Several upstairs rooms have poor circulation, while the basement rooms need space heaters to keep them warm enough in the winter. These issues can compromise the effectiveness of our ministry and stifle growth.

Little Trinity also ministers to an average of a dozen infants and toddlers each week in the two nurseries. The Infant Room (and attached crib room) is in dire need of a number of improvements to keep our babies safe and happy. The Toddler Room is a makeshift area in the basement which is too far away from the washroom and often used to access a storage area where tables and chairs are kept.

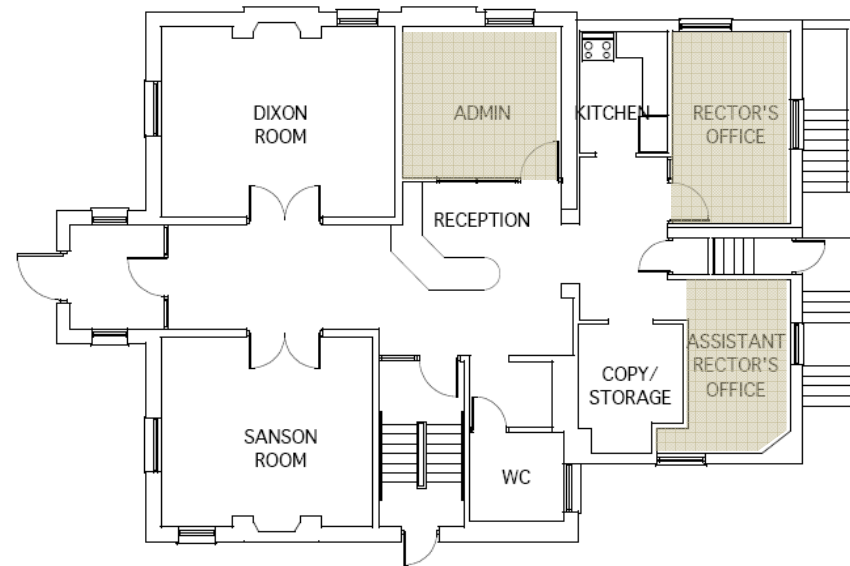
